Themes for the Month of June

- MEMORY VERSE: Faith is being sure of what we hope for. It is being sure of what we do not see. Hebrews 11:1, NIrV
- LIFE APP
- Faith—Trusting in what you can't see because of what you can see
- BOTTOM LINE
- You can know Jesus even though you've never seen Him.
- BASIC TRUTH
- I can trust God no matter what

- Activity #1:
- Call out a series of clues to guide kids to guess people who you "met" this week.
- Once kids guess who the person is, guide them to come up with a motion to represent that person.
- Clues: (on the next page)

- CLUES
- A: The person wears a uniform most of the time. They help keep everything clean and tidy. (Maid, Custodian or Janitor)
- B: helps you at a special place. This person may read you a book or help you find a book. (Librarian)
- C: .. is older than you are. When there aren't any grownups at home, they take care of you. (Babysitter)
- D: helps you do your best. You'll find them in a school. They help you learn how to do new things. (Teacher)
- E:... is the leader of a team. They help you know how to play the game. (Coach)
- F: wears special clothes. They help when you have trouble. You would see this person if there was a fire. (Firefighter)

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WHAT YOU SAY:

• "How were you able to guess the person I met? Did you see them? Did you talk to them? (Pause.) No? Then how did you know who they were? (You gave us clue. You told us about them. You told us what they do.) Yes! Even though you didn't see them yourselves, you knew who they were when I told you about them. [Transition] In the Video we'll hear about Someone else you can know even though you've never seen Him."

- Activity #3 –WHAT'S IN MY BAG?
- MATERIALS NEEDED: pillow case, a stuffed animal, a shoe, book, toy.
- Put one item at a time in the pillowcase. Keeping the pillowcase closed, have your child feel it and try to identify it. Check and see if they are correct. Change items and try it again with all items.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- "So, what's in my pillowcase? (Pause.) How do you know? (Invite answers.) (Pull out the item for kids to see.) So, even though you couldn't see what was inside the pillowcase, you knew what was inside! You felt that it was a (stuffed animal) and that it had (something on its head or on its feet). Then, [kid's name] told you about it, and you knew for certain what it was.
- "You know what? The same thing can be true about us and Jesus. Can you see Jesus? No, you can't see Jesus, but you can know Jesus even though you've never seen Him. You can know Him because you can see and hear how He's worked in others' lives.
